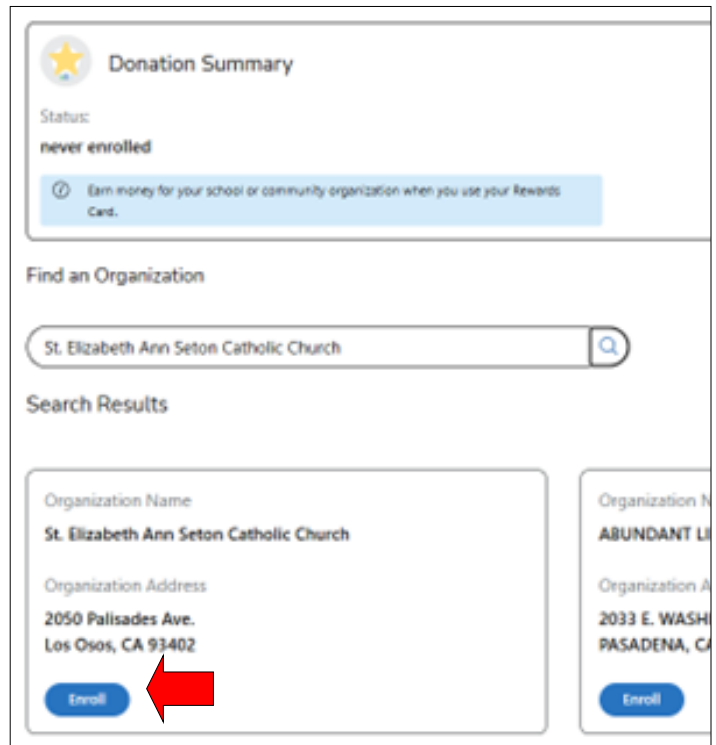

STEP 4: Click on the button for 'Community Rewards.'

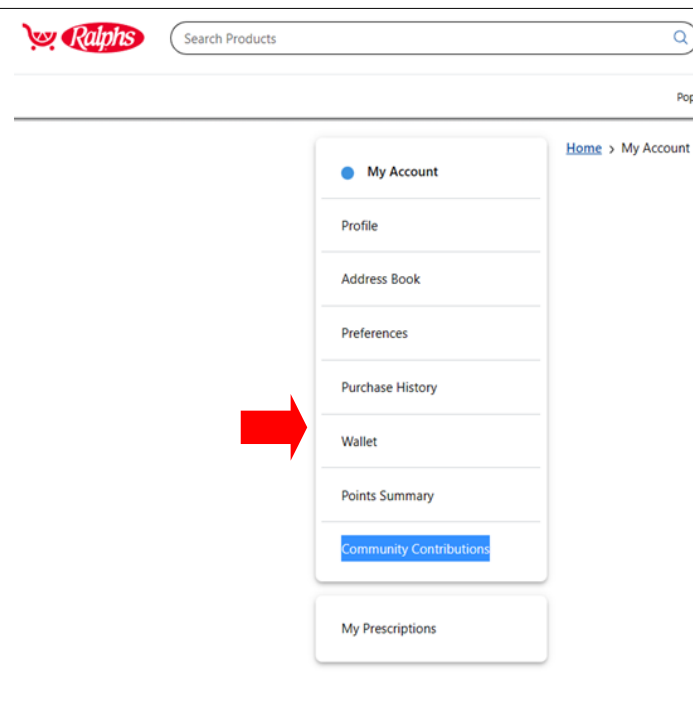

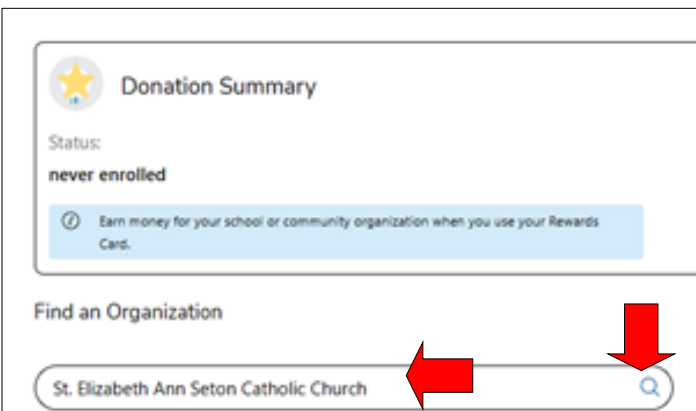
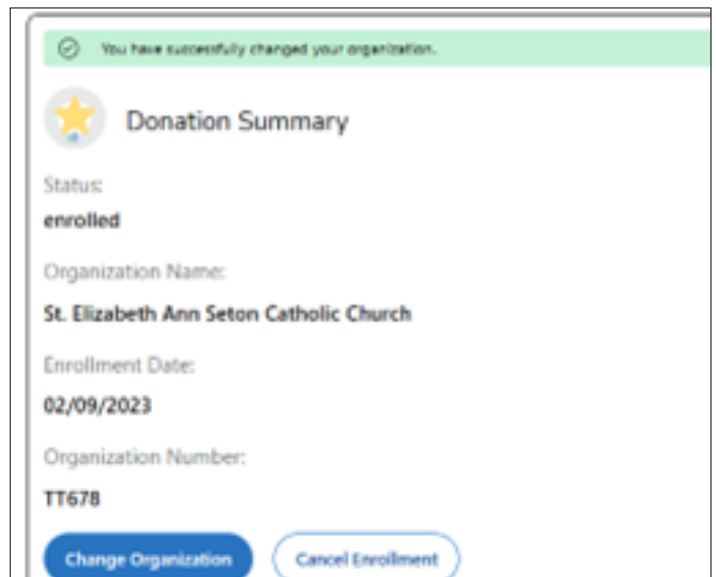
STEP 7: Your screen should then change and offer you a donation summary which shows that you are now enrolled with our parish benefitting from the Ralph's Community Rewards Program.

Los socios de CRS ya están respondiendo en Turquía y Siria

CRS apoya a socios locales para brindar ayuda urgente tras terremotos mortales

El 6 de febrero, un terremoto de magnitud 7.8 devastó grandes áreas del sur de Turquía y el noroeste de Siria. El número de muertos ha superado los 19,000 y sigue aumentando. Miles de personas han resultado heridas y muchas están atrapadas bajo los escombros. El terremoto es el peor que ha azotado a Turquía en este siglo. En las siguientes 24 horas, la región experimentó múltiples réplicas y un segundo sismo de magnitud 7.5.

Las zonas más afectadas en Turquía incluyen Kahramanmaraş, Hatay, Osmaniye, Adıyaman, Gaziantep, Şanlıurfa, Diyarbakır, Malatya y Adana. El norte de Siria se vio muy afectado en Aleppo, Idlib, Hama y Latakia. Líbano experimentó daños limitados, principalmente en la ciudad norteña de Trípoli.

En las zonas afectadas se han arrasado edificios de apartamentos y escuelas. Las telecomunicaciones están interrumpidas, lo que impide que las familias identifiquen y contabilicen a sus seres queridos desaparecidos. En Siria, las personas desplazadas buscan refugio en escuelas y centros comunitarios en zonas ya devastadas por años de guerra. En todo el sur de Turquía, las escuelas están cerradas, el transporte aeroportuario está afectado y los hospitales han sido declarados inutilizables. A estos retos se suman las temperaturas invernales extremas. El sur de Turquía y el norte de Siria están experimentando nieve y aguanieve, y es probable que haya más temperaturas gélidas en los próximos días. Entre las necesidades más apremiantes, comunicadas por nuestros socios, se encuentran refugio seguro, alimentos, medicamentos y suministros de invierno, como mantas para mantener abrigadas a las familias.

Estaremos apoyando a Cáritas Turquía y Cáritas Siria en Alepo y Latakia, donde se han reportado daños extensos. En Turquía, Cáritas Anatolia, en coordinación con las autoridades locales, ya está llevando a las personas desplazadas a espacios abiertos y seguros y distribuyendo comida caliente y ropa.

CRS Partners Already Responding in Turkey and Syria

CRS supports local partners to provide urgent relief following deadly earthquakes

On February 6, a 7.8 magnitude earthquake devastated large areas of southern Turkey and northwest Syria. The death toll has surpassed 19,000 and continues to climb. Thousands of people have been injured and many are trapped beneath the rubble. The earthquake is the worst to strike Turkey this century. Within the subsequent 24 hours, the region experienced multiple aftershocks and a second 7.5 magnitude quake.

Areas most affected in Turkey include Kahramanmaraş, Hatay, Osmaniye, Adiyaman, Gaziantep, Şanlıurfa, Diyarbakır, Malatya and Adana. Northern Syria was heavily affected in Aleppo, Idlib, Hama and Latakia. Lebanon experienced limited damage, mostly in the northern city of Tripoli.

Across affected areas, apartment buildings and schools have been leveled. Telecommunications are disrupted, preventing families' from identifying and accounting for missing loved ones. In Syria, displaced people are seeking shelter in schools and community centers in areas already devastated by years of war. Across southern Turkey, schools are closed, airport transportation is impaired and hospitals have been declared unusable. Compounding these challenges are extreme winter temperatures. Southern Turkey and northern Syria are experiencing snow and sleet, with more freezing temperatures likely in the days to come. Among the most pressing needs communicated by our partners are safe shelter, food, medication, and winter supplies such as blankets to keep families warm.

CRS SUPPORT TO LOCAL PARTNERS' RESPONSE

Catholic Relief Services is supporting local partners in their efforts to provide urgent relief and assistance for long-term recovery. CRS has partnerships with Caritas Turkey and Caritas Syria, as well as other local partners. We will be supporting Caritas Turkey and Caritas Syria in Aleppo and Latakia, where extensive damage has been reported. In Turkey, Caritas Anatolia, in coordination with local authorities, is already bringing displaced people to safe, open spaces and distributing hot meals and clothing.

The proceeds from this wonderful fundraiser will support those directly affected by the recent floods in Los Osos / Baywood, Morro Bay and Cayucos.

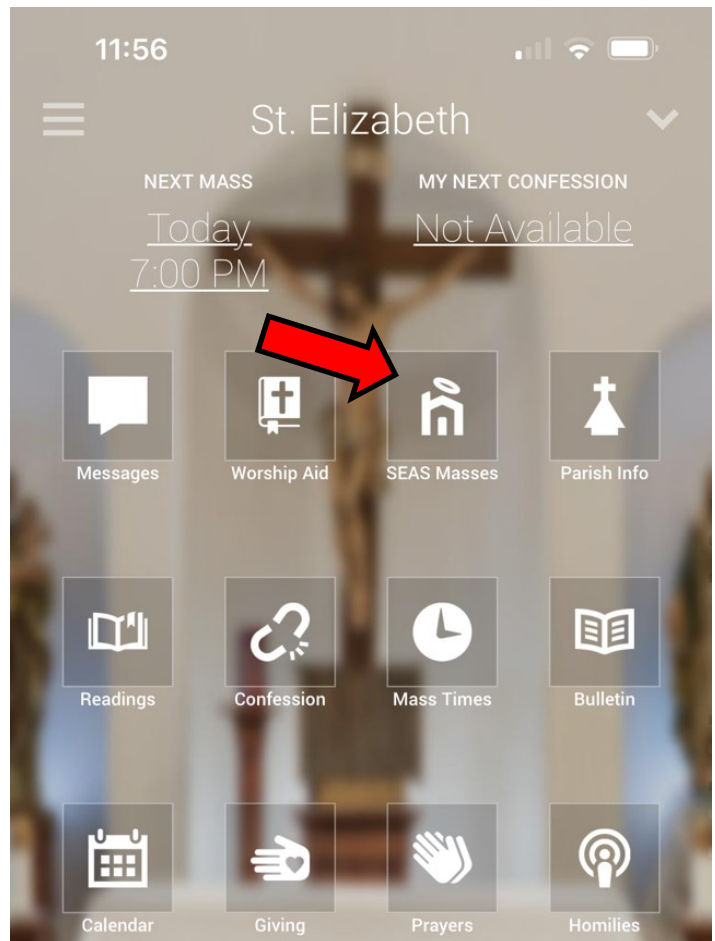
Cost is \$20 per person which includes barbequed chicken, side dishes and dessert, followed by a 1 Act Play with Rick and Sharyn Young.

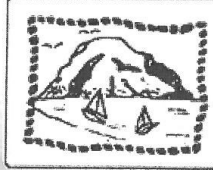
