Dear brothers and sisters in the Church of Monterey:

“Christ is Risen!” This wonderful proclamation by the Eastern Church is always followed by the response, “He is risen indeed!” It is as if a simple proclamation cannot contain the great joy of that message.

I think of the weeping Mary Magdalene, after the crucifixion and burial, going to the tomb and not finding Jesus. She is forlorn. Seeing a man and supposing him the gardener, she asks where he carried Jesus, to which the ‘gardener’ responds, “Mary!” Hearing his voice calling her name, her heart recognized what her sight could not. She knew it was Jesus and she responded no doubt with great joy and emotion, “Rabboni!” (which means teacher).

Perhaps many of us in our world this Easter are very much like the weeping Mary Magdalene. We come to Jesus in tears.... from the Pajaro Valley where many have lost everything, from Ukraine, filled with nightmares of war, from poverty, loneliness, broken lives, and broken relationships we often come with broken hearts.

This Easter the Spirit is inviting us to stop and see Jesus looking into our eyes with great love, and calling us by name. Let us ask him to open our hearts to his love, to increase our faith and hope and give us courage to live this hope in our words and actions with others. Christ is alive! - and he wishes us to carry him into all the parts of ‘our worlds.’ May others see in us the hope and love that Mary Magdalene saw in the Risen Lord. **Christ is Risen! He is Risen indeed!**

Quizás muchos de nosotros esta Pascua nos parecemos a María Magdalena quien lloró. Nosotros también venimos a Jesús con lágrimas... como las lágrimas del Valle del Pájaro donde muchos lo han perdido todo, como las personas de Ucrania, llenas de pesadillas por la guerra, la pobreza, la soledad, las vidas, relaciones y corazones quebrantados.

Esta Pascua el Espíritu nos está invitando a detenernos y ver a Jesús mirándonos a los ojos con gran amor y llamándonos por nuestro nombre. Pidámosle que abra nuestros corazones a su amor, que aumente nuestra fe y esperanza y nos dé valor para vivir esta esperanza en nuestras palabras y acciones con los demás. ¡Cristo vive! - y desea que lo llevemos a todas partes de 'nuestros mundos'. De tal forma que los demás vean en nosotros la esperanza y el amor que María Magdalena vio en el Señor Resucitado. **¡Cristo ha resucitado! ¡Él ha resucitado!**

Sunday, April 9, 2023

Alleluia!

*Today's readings: Acts 10:34a, 37-43; Psalm 118:1-2, 16-17, 22-23; Colossians 3:1-4 or 1 Corinthians 5:6b-8; Sequence Victimae paschali laudes; John 20:1-9 or Matthew 28:1-10 or, at an afternoon or evening Mass, Luke 24:13-35.* Celebrating Easter is like watching the sunrise in the most beautiful place ever visited. All along our journey through Lent our eyes have been tuned for directional arrows in the Scriptures pointing our steps toward God, who summons us unceasingly.

At Easter we open our hearts fully as the Son rises gloriously and his rays fill us with joy. Together with the

community of faith, we renew our baptismal vows. Like a long-married couple renewing their marriage vows, we baptized Christians renew our commitment to Jesus Christ and the Church. We welcome sprinkles of blessed baptismal water as a symbol of our bond in faith. It is a joyous response to God's invitation to return to him with ready hearts. The resurrection is celebrated with our jubilant renewal of faith as the Gloria and Alleluia are sung and trumpets and bells resound. Our sanctuaries and homes are filled with fragrant flowers and our tables hold choice foods to share with those we love. The Son is alive and with us always! Alleluia!





## THIS WEEK AT HOME

### Monday, April 10 Do Not Be Afraid

In Matthew's resurrection account, the first appearance of the risen Lord is to Mary Magdalene and "the other Mary." The encounter is utterly unexpected. The women were looking for the disciples. They could not imagine seeing Jesus. The first words Jesus speaks are "Peace" and "Do not be afraid." With their fear dispelled, the women embrace their call to be the first witnesses of the risen Christ. *Today's readings: Acts 2:14, 22-33; Psalm 16:1-2a and 5, 7-8, 9-10, 11; Matthew 28:8-15.*

### Tuesday, April 11 Called by Name

John's resurrection account mirrors Matthew's in that the first appearance of the risen Lord is to Mary Magdalene. Consumed with grief and confusion, Mary is unable to recognize Jesus until he calls her by name. At the sound of her name, Mary is forever transformed. With certainty, she announces the good news. On the day of our baptism, and continually throughout our lives, God calls us by name and sends us as living witnesses to the world. *Today's readings: Acts 2:36-41; Psalm 33:4-5, 18-19, 20 and 22; John 20:11-18.*

### Wednesday, April 12 Be Alert

There is so much good news to unpack and celebrate about the resurrection of Jesus that the Church gives us fifty days in the Easter season to do this. Today is one of the many times when we hear about the time Jesus appeared to the disciples on the road to Emmaus. He approaches and walks with them, first listening, then teaching, and ultimately revealing. Jesus does that with each of us, day by day, through the Easter season. Be alert for when he shows up! *Today's readings: Acts 3:1-10; Psalm 105:1-2, 3-4, 6-7, 8-9; Luke 24:13-35.*

### Thursday, April 13 Go Deeper

As Jesus ate and spoke with his disciples in Jerusalem, Luke tells us that "he opened their minds to understand the Scriptures" (Luke 24:45). He reinterpreted sacred Scripture in light of his birth, death, and resurrection, revealing a new layer of meaning about the plan of God. How might we allow our daily reading of the Scriptures through this Easter season to bring us to a deeper understanding of the paschal mystery in our time? *Today's readings: Acts 3:11-26; Psalm 8:2ab and 5, 6-7, 8-9; Luke 24:35-48.*

### Friday, April 14 Fifty Days

Today we hear from John about Jesus' third appearance to his disciples, this time on the beach of the Sea of Tiberias. The disciples have returned to their occupation of fishing. Jesus will be sending them back to the vocation to which he called them as evangelists. Jesus did not give up on his beloved disciples; he does not give up on us. Easter is not over; it has just begun. During these fifty days of Easter, we have time to contemplate how the Lord draws us close, feeds us, and empowers us to be living witnesses of joy. *Today's readings: Acts 4:1-12; Psalm 118:1-2 and 4, 22-24, 25-27a; John 21:1-14.*

### Saturday, April 15 Go Out to the Whole World

The octave (eight days) of Easter concludes with Mark's account of how Jesus appeared first to Mary Magdalene. She immediately went to announce the good news. But, alas, she was met with resistance and disbelief. Witnessing the truth of Jesus Christ in today's culture requires confronting skepticism and rejection. But as Jesus instructed the disciples then, he commands us now to persist and "Go into the whole world and proclaim the gospel to every creature" (Mark 16:15). *Today's readings: Acts 4:13-21; Psalm 118:1 and 14-15ab, 16-18, 19-21; Mark 16:9-15.*

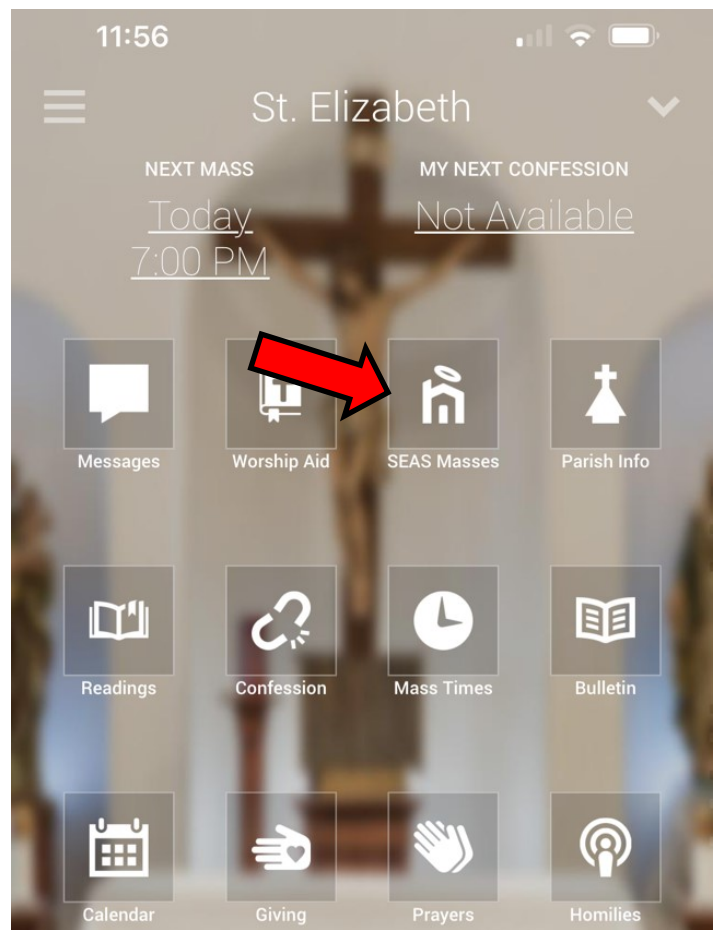

## HERE I HAM; I COME TO EAT MY FILL



On Monday April 3rd parish volunteers prepared and served nearly 100 persons for People's Kitchen at the Prado Center in San Luis Obispo.

Our parish monthly prepares a meal to be served at the 40 Prado

center in San Luis Obispo on Prado through the People's Kitchen which was established in 1983 in response to hungry, homeless, or unemployed people looking for food locally in dumpsters. Our parish team of volunteers is led by Chief

Servant, Sharon Kroll, who plans healthy, well balanced meals with dessert to be served. Our parish serves the first Monday of the month, in rotation with other religious and secular groups from throughout our county.

## FUNDRAISING AT S.E.A.S.

Throughout the year there are numerous fundraisers put forth by our parish to raise money for various services and needs at our parish.

The most well known fundraiser at our parish is the SEAS International Festival. Already there has been discussion and small committee meetings to prepare for the larger group meetings. The SEAS International Festival is held on the 3rd Sunday in September.

This last week a small tamale fundraiser was held at the request of the local fire station who asked if they could have some tamales. Margarita Arroyo and a small team prepared these tamales. The funds donated went to our building fund for our new roof. In the past Arroyo and others have helped with tamale fundraisers directed at the different Mass attendees for the roof.

Likewise Maggie Carlson in December has held small fundraisers for the roof fund, selling handcrafted goods and estate jewelry that she collected.

Another type of fundraiser is our Saint Joseph's Table held in March that benefits our St. Joseph's Fund. Our parish office is approached regularly by people seeking help with partial rent payments and utility payments. On occasion we also get requests for help with groceries and gasoline. Unfortunately due to those living on Palisades during the COVID years our office was inundated with people living on the street taking advantage of what we offered, especially asking for gas and grocery help: On particular days the parish office was inundated with several persons and later they were seen barbecuing and had multiple bottles of alcohol. In light of this, a new policy was implemented to help persons once a year.

## MISSION SLO HOSTS S.E.A.S. CONFIRMATION

The Confirmation Candidates from St. Elizabeth Ann Seton and Mission San Luis Obispo enjoyed a joint Confirmation Retreat and Rite of Commitment at Mission SLO on March 18th, 2023.

In part of an effort for local parishes to support each other, our parish Coordinator for English Faith Formation, Heather Hurley, and the Director of Religious Education at the Mission, Laura Pompa worked together since January to develop a joint retreat for the Confirmation Candidates at both parishes.

Pompa and Hurley enlisted the help of several young people, both current and former Newman students, to help as a panel for a Q & A session for the youth. Fr. Martin Cain (Mission SLO Pastor) and Raphael Revina spoke on

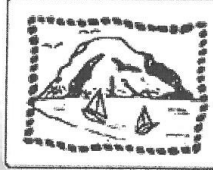
