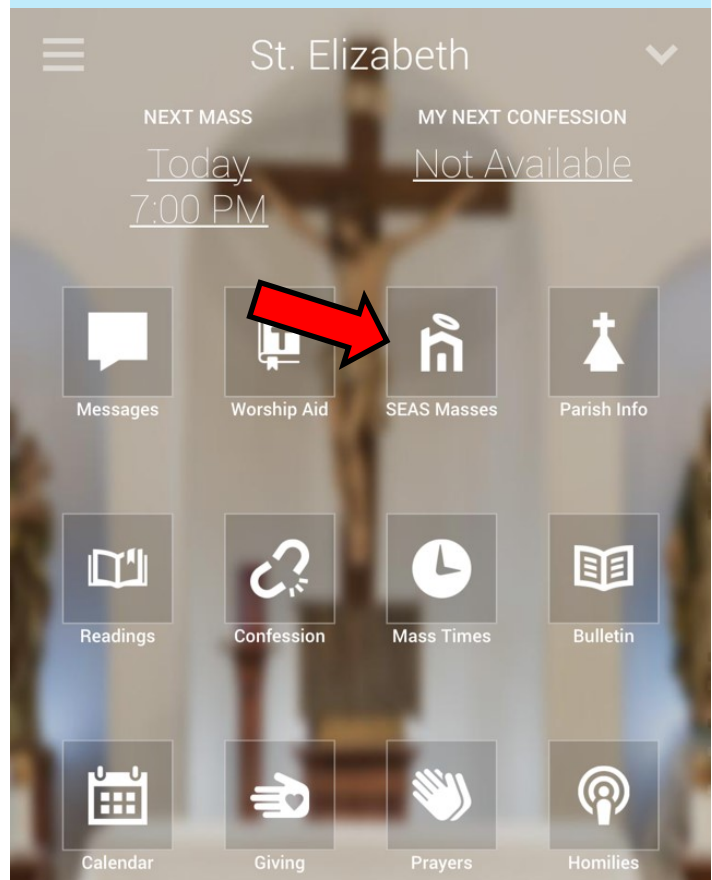

Dear Friends,

When I think of telling you about how the Eucharist has touched my heart, I feel more like exclaiming with the saints: O, my Heart! I wonder where would I even be if I had never encountered Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament on the few occasions I was invited by friends in my youth to attend their Catholic Church - me who had received no more religious education from my family than to have gotten the vague idea that we were probably Christian? Do my encounters with Him there in his Church explain why I felt a strong desire, as my children were born, to teach them about God, even though I didn't know Him very well myself? When our family was welcomed into modern Christian (not Catholic) churches, would I have realized that the children and myself needed to be baptized, if I'd never been near the Eucharist? Would I have realized my marriage needed to be blessed by God?

Fortunately, the Lord had blessed me with the natural grace of ready obedience, so as I came to understand what needed to be done, I did it. All the way to following the inspiration of the Holy Spirit into the Catholic Church, ten years ago. The first Mass I prayerfully participated in as a baptized Christian was here at SEAS in September of 2013. After that experience, I knew deep down I could never leave the Catholic Church to attend elsewhere again. Eight months later, in my formal instruction with Fr Joey, I received my first teaching about the true presence of Jesus Christ, and indeed the Holy Trinity, in the Eucharist. Now I finally understood why I felt such a strong and immediate bond with a church I barely knew!

Thanks be to God, at the Easter Vigil in 2016, I received my First Holy Communion. Being able to take Christ into my own body must have made it easier for Jesus to make me a living and active part of His body. I've been blessed ever since to see my life transform in many happy ways, from the inside out. It seemed easy to recognize habits and patterns that needed to change in my vocations of wife, mother, and homemaker, family member and friend. And, with continued reception of the Holy Eucharist at Mass, I've had the wisdom and patience to undertake and sustain those changes.

One new habit was to check out the church bulletin and participate in what was being offered that seemed interesting. This is how my regular habit of Adoration began. I didn't know what this word referred to in the church, but I saw it on the schedule and since I had time, I decided to check it out. This was many years ago, when Fr. Joey was new here. My fellow adorers informed me that they felt very blessed that our new priest liked to participate in the prayers during Adoration time, instead of just sitting nearby. Needless to say, this premium experience of adoring Jesus Christ in the

Blessed Sacrament, together with the priest and his faithful flock, easily got me hooked. From the start, I was pretty committed to making a Holy Hour at Adoration once a week. Now, my husband and I feel abundantly blessed to be able to visit the Adoration Chapel here at SEAS daily. With all the chaos that comes in life every day, where would I be without this anchor of Peace I've found in adoration and reception of the Eucharist? O, my Heart!

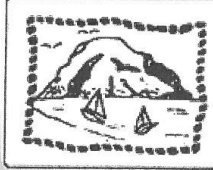
