## WITNESSING CHRIST IN THE EUCHARIST



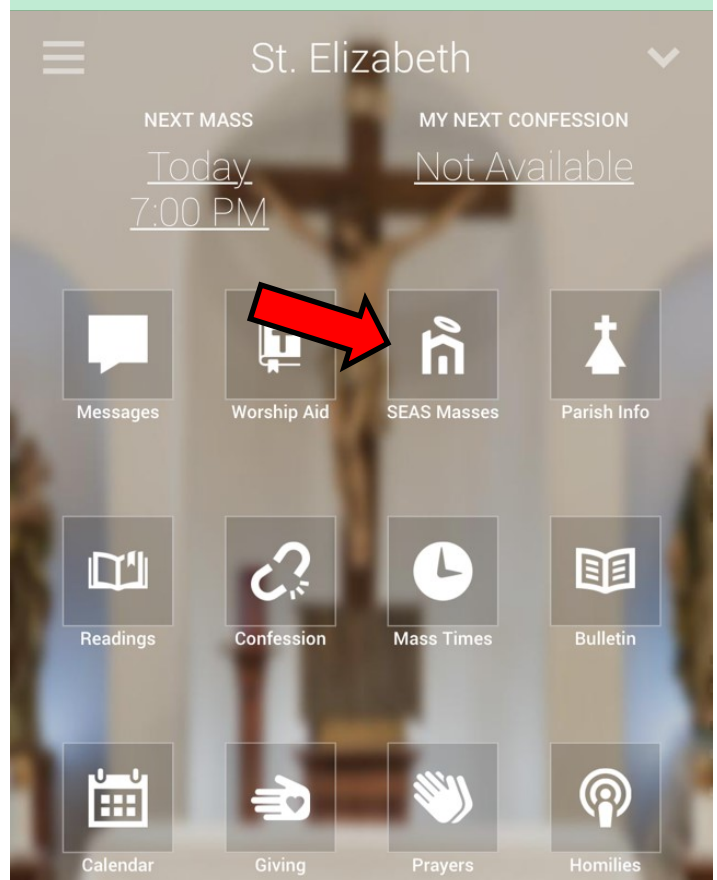
During this year of Eucharistic Renewal we have a section of the bulletin dedicated to **your** stories of how the Blessed Eucharist has touched your life.

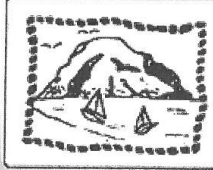
