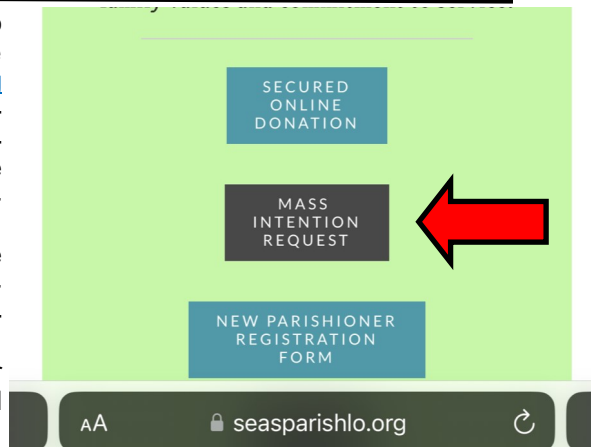
## SUMMER STEWARDSHIP STAGNATION

There is a yearly trend during the summer of financial stewardship stagnation at parishes as parishioners escape jobs and school for a little summer adventure.

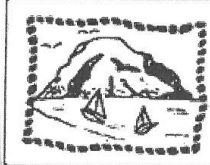
Our parish is really grateful to those who contribute during the summer months.
