You had asked, I have been asked, what is the Eucharist. As a Catholic, and for me it was simple to say, it is "the body and blood of Christ". But that answer left me somewhat wanting more, empty, because I felt it didn't address the meaning of the Eucharist. The following event I'm about to share helped me to better understand the meaning of the Eucharist, warning, you may find this disturbing or sad, but it beautifully shows how sacred life can be.

My ailing mother in law, and I share the loss of someone we both loved very much, my wife and her daughter. She is currently recovering in a hospital where I paid her a visit recently. When I walked in on her I found her sleeping. Her nursing staff had been trying to wake her but she just stayed peacefully asleep.

Upon reaching the side of her bed, I spoke or called to her, she apparently recognized my voice, and slowly opened her eyes. Once she focused on me a smile came across her face. It was at that moment that I had a look or glimpse back into her eyes and saw what I can only describe as Gods' love.

What I felt at that moment is the point I'm trying to make, as is in terms of the Eucharist, as it has the appearance of bread and wine, it is the substance of our Lord Jesus, similar to what I my mother-in-law saw in me, she saw me present, myself, but also sensed the substance of our loss, my wife, her daughter.
