

### 22 & 23 JULY—MISSIONARY APPEAL

Fr. Constantine Mlelwa, O.S.A. is celebrating Mass with us this weekend, July 22 & 23. Fr. Constantine represents the Catholic Diocese of Shinyanga. He is here to share about his community and the people that they serve within the Diocese of Shinyanga in the hopes that we might be able to offer some financial charity their way.

Tanzania has a population of over 50 million people. The Diocese of Shinyanga has 3.3 million people, 1,021,000 of whom are Catholic or to put another way, 31% of all the people who live in the region of the Diocese of Shinyanga are Catholic. The Missionary Appeal this weekend aids in

- Pastoral Care for HIV/AIDS (HIV/AIDS epidemic are related to the gold mines, and trade route to Rwanda and Barundi; and to the open markets.
- Education for orphans, and adolescent girls from poor families who would otherwise be forced into arranged marriages for the bride price from the groom's family. Average tuition is \$600 per year.
- Faith Formation (Catechism)
- Construction of a hostel for priests
- Construction of the Shanwa Seminary, which was started in 1998 and is still lacking chapel, laboratory, dining hall, staff rooms, learning and teaching materials, and books and supplies. The Diocese has 19 seminarians, so some of this funding would also help pay the cost of their tuition.
- Drilling shallow wells to supply clean and safe water; In rural areas women and young people walk long distances to get water from rivers or exposed dams. Sometimes these young people and women are attacked and raped. A single well costs \$6,690.



### **EXPLICACIÓN DE LA MISA**


