Michealangelo's *Pieta*, that image of Mary holding her son when he is taken down from the Cross, is heart wrenching, however it sums up in a single image what a mother is: She is someone who nurtures and protects her children, forms their values, and influences their emotional and spiritual growth; A mother is there in times of joy and in times of sadness and grief; A mother is there in our failures and catastrophes: A mother is there in our triumphs and victories; Even before we are born a mother carries within her the seed of life, loving and nurturing, giving of her own self to provide for the babe; she will contemplate, hope for the future. Just as the bridegroom tells his bride, *"You are beautiful in every way, there is no flaw in you."* (Songs 4:7), so the bride turned mother reminds her child of that too. The Church, the mystical Bride of Christ, is our Mother, offering freely a tender love through her sacrificial outpouring of her holy gifts through Christ upon us.

There is a tenderness in love that compels us to bring forth from our inmost self, a selfless outpouring of seeking the good of another before ourselves. Just like Elijah who sits in the cave on the mountain of Horeb listening for the Lord, as one does a lover, he knows it is not the Lord in the loud violence of the strong wind, nor the earthquake, nor the fire that consumes and destroys. No, he listened with faith for the love of the most high God who gently calls.

It is interesting that love comes freely and gently. In Holy Scripture we catch glimpses of examples of people loving in imitation of God. Consider the story of the widow with the widow's mite. (Mark 12:41-44, Luke 21:1-4) There was a great number of people creating a cacophony of sound for entertainment by putting different size coins into the donation boxes at the temple. The widow in her great love gave what she had out of love for our Lord God.

Have you ever considered why she out of love for God gave her money to the temple? Why the temple and not someone or something else?

Perhaps it is because through the continuous nurturing of the Word of God through Scripture, through the rituals, and through the sustaining faith in good times and bad, in her sickness and health, in wealth and in poverty, that she

recognized that beautiful relationship between God the Father and his people, just as we do Christ and the Church. In that love offered freely to her, the widow responded in faith by giving herself and all that she was to the one who gently called to her, called to Elijah, calls to us.

A mother's love comes freely and it spreads. Have you ever really listened to the Prayers of the Faithful at Mass? Our Holy Mother Church has such deep love that she lifts up and offers her concerns for the Church, for the world, for those in need, for those who have died. She holds them, hold us, in her arms close to her heart just as we see Jesus held so close to Mary's bosom in the *Pieta*.

The Church, our Mother, is a mother and teacher. As we as ourselves, *"What do I want to do with my life?" "How should I live my life?"* Our Mother the Church teaches us the ways that will lead us to salvation and everlasting life, for she is the spouse of Christ, and as Christ Jesus told his Apostles, *"Whoever listens to you listens to me."* (Lk 10:16) She teaches of God's unbridled love for us, his children, by showing us how to share his love, or *caritas* (charity) for others through loving merciful acts.

Whether it is the Church through the leadership of the bishops in different places of the world: e.g. in Ecuador condemning violence after a presidential candidate there was killed; or the bishops of West Africa protecting those they can from violent military interventions in Niger; or the bishops in Slovenia joining with another Church entity like *Caritas* to help flood victims; or even our own Bishop Danny who guides us in helping others through various means like Catholic Charities Diocese of Monterey which helps with many challenges including immigrant issues, disaster relief from the storms early this year; helping those who made bad decisions early in life and need a helping hand up, etc.; and intimately at the parish with things like Peoples Kitchen, St. Joseph's fund, AMA, and a percentage of our Sunday collection given to the Diocese to help our Mother the Church help our brothers and sisters, we follow what our Mother teaches us: to love and give freely of ourselves and the gifts we have been given to share.

And so, 'Cuz We Love, We Give. It is our way of life.

## FABULOUS FOOD

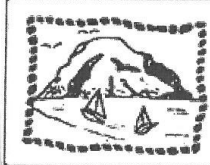
People's Kitchen volunteers helped with food preparation and serving this past Monday, August 7th to be served at 40 Prado.
