Perhaps you have heard a parent talk about their concern for their child, or maybe you are a parent and have experienced the worry for your child. Parents worry about their children all the time. It is the nature of a parent to love their child. Worry and concern are aspects of love: Parents want what is best for their children. Even in Holy Scripture we see an example in Salome, the mother of the Apostles James and John, trying to look out for the good of her children by asking Jesus if they could sit at his right and left hand. (Mt 20:20) The Church is like a mother in her loving concern and wanting what is best for us collectively and individually, always nurturing.

What was your immediate emotional response to the devastation in Lahaina, HI in the news for the past week? With the wildfire in Maui we see our Mother, the Church's response in helping our brothers and sisters in need who are struggling to rebuild their families, their livelihoods and their homes. Remembering that the Church is the collective Body of us believers acting as one through the leadership appointed by Christ and given to successors the Apostles, and to our Bishops today, we, the Church are present in a very real way through Bishop Silva who is helping to coordinate financial donations to benefit the people in Diocese of Honolulu through the Hawaii Catholic Community Foundation and Catholic Charities Hawaii. Not only is our Mother the Church helping financially, but she is also there in person as priests and trained laity serving food, providing housing, other essential needs, and the Sacraments. All of us collectively all around the world, gathered as Church, are present in a real way with our prayers for all the victims of the fire; these are prayers of the Holy Mother Church holding her precious child in need close to her heart.

Our Mother the Church also provides for us what we need to nourish us on a daily basis. For some this means the opportunity for Holy Mass and/or Adoration either in person, livestream, and/or radio for the homebound or working. For others nourishment can be received in other forms, maybe through parish Faith Sharing groups, like at our parish on Thursday mornings. For others the nourishment may also come through other meaningful exchanges

where the Church gathered together: *"For where two or three gather in my name, there am I in their midst."* (Mt 18:20) One of these other meaningful exchanges happened at the annual World Youth Day, which was held this month in Lisbon, Portugal where over 1.5 million of the Faithful including 700 bishops and 10,000 priests (*ABCNews.com, 8/6/2023*) and all representing every nation, except for the Maldives, according to Aleteia (*Aleteia.com, 8/1/2023*) gathered with Pope Francis to celebrate Christ Jesus, Our Lord and Savior through shared learning experiences, speeches offered by Pope Francis and Others, and through the Most Holy Eucharist. There, our Mother the Church to her younger children, who are often unsure of who they are and their place in the world, reminded them and us through the words of Pope Francis to not be afraid of failing, but to follow our dreams and especially to the young people all around the world, *"As young people, you want to change the world and it is good that you want to change the world and work for justice and peace. The Church and the world need you, the young, as much as the earth needs rain."*

This weekend at our parish we experience that warm nurturing hand of our Mother as we celebrate the Mass of the Holy Spirit at our 9:00am on Sunday to welcome in not just the school year, but also our catechetical year with all our young learners preparing for the Sacraments of First Holy Communion, Confirmation, and those in grade school preparing for their Baptism, First Communion and Confirmation at the Easter Vigil. Just like the love of their parents who will be offering their time in volunteering at our parish this year, these little ones will also offer service this year out of love as they learn better to imitate our Lord within our community from each of us in various ways: to offer our monetary gifts at Mass for parish and Diocesan needs; bring up the offering of Bread and Wine on behalf of our community; proclaim the Word of God; share the 'Bread of Angels;' help with the cleaning & dusting of the church; pull weeds; celebrate together at the Festival; Adore together, and celebrate the Mass. Why? This is the Way that Jesus shared with us. He is the Way. So, 'coz we love, we give.

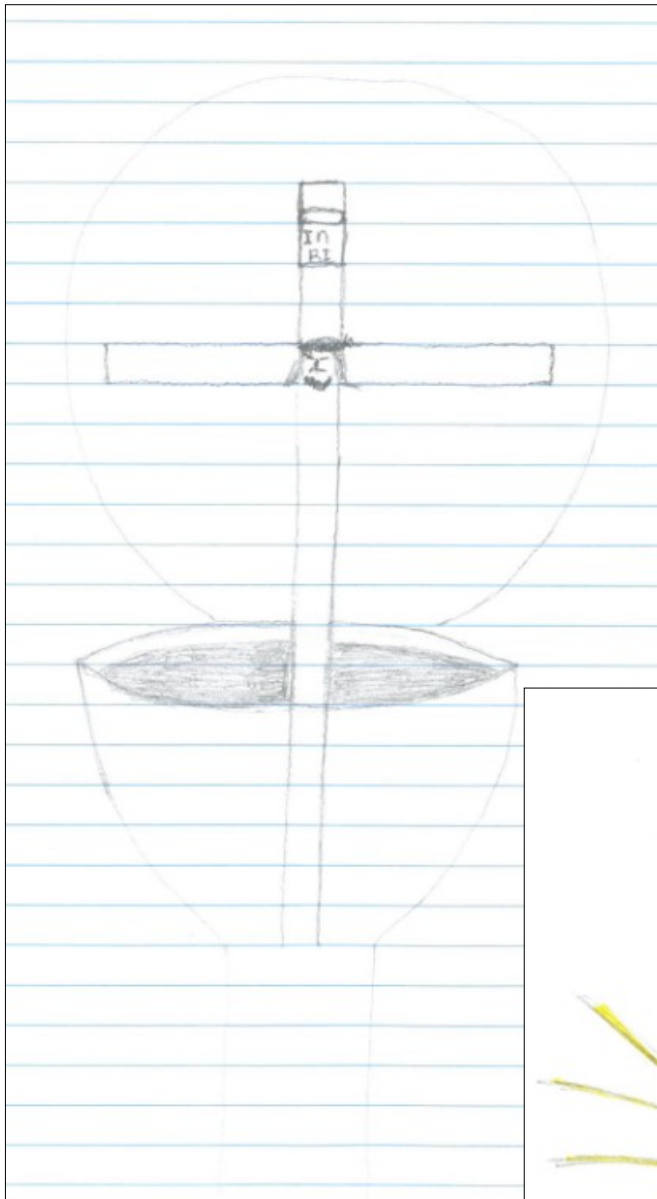
