There is a beloved children’s book, *Stone Soup*, that discusses a village of people whose hearts are grown cold like stone. The people have seen too many hard times, dealt with famine, floods, and war. Everyone is unhappy and miserable, indifferent toward each other. To strangers to the village, they are not kind. One day visitors, monks, came to town and saw how the people were. The visitors decide to make soup from stones. A little girl comes to ask if they need a bigger pot, her mother brings it to them. Soon others begin to offer little things, a carrot here, a potato there, and so on. Soon the soup is ready and all are able to sit together and enjoy the meal that they all prepared, and welcoming strangers as friends.

How easy it is to close ourselves off to others when we have been hurt or suffered, closing ourselves off and becoming indifferent, like people with hearts of stone. In Matthew 18:21-35 we hear Peter say to Jesus, “Lord, if my brother sins against me, how often must I forgive? As many as seven times?” Being hurt is not pleasant. It is almost like Peter is looking for that excuse to be able to turn inward and not care.

In our day, things haven’t changed. Don’t we hear about people trying to cut ‘toxic’ people out of their lives? Cutting someone out of one’s life is easily justified by saying that it doesn’t mean that they are hated, simply that one respects themselves or values themselves more. Another justification for cutting out a toxic person can be the idea that if there are fewer negative persons in one’s life, life will become more peaceful. Maybe those ‘toxic’ people have a solution for every problem; have opinions that reflect their beliefs; maybe they are viewed as broken, lonely, or outwardly boring; perhaps they are viewed as ‘not worth it anymore.’ A quick internet search will give many different websites for how to cut ‘toxic’ people out of one’s life. Perhaps Peter is thinking about a toxic person that he knows personally, maybe a family member or a friend, and wants to cut all ties with them because he feels like that person is just not worth the heartache and headache anymore: maybe he is so frustrated and believes that person will never change, so why? Why forgive them? Why keep going?

God love Peter, he is so much like us! What does Jesus say? “I say to you, not seven times but seventy-seven times.” Peter, like us, are called to keep forgiving. Jesus continues with the parable of the kingdom of heaven likened to the king who settled accounts with his servants which discusses forgiveness.

Our Holy Mother the Church in our catechism reminds us that (CCC 982) *There is no offense, however serious, that the Church cannot forgive. “There is no one, however wicked and guilty, who may not confidently hope for forgiveness, provided his repentance is honest.” Christ who died for all men desires that in his Church the gates of forgiveness should always be open to anyone who turns away from sin.*

We never know when someone will change or how it will change. When we think of others, we need to remember that we see them through our own lens. Maybe our lens needs to be corrected, our hearts reconfigured to be more like Christ’s own heart which is loving and full of warmth. Maybe we don’t realize that cutting a person out of our lives hurts them deeply.

CCC 1432 says, *“The human heart is heavy and hardened. God must give man a new heart.”<sup>25</sup> Conversion is first of all a work of the grace of God who makes our hearts return to him: “Restore us to thyself, O LORD, that we may be restored!”<sup>26</sup> God gives us the strength to begin anew. It is in discovering the greatness of God’s love that our heart is shaken by the horror and weight of sin and begins to fear offending God by sin and being separated from him. The human heart is converted by looking upon him whom our sins have pierced.”*

Our Holy Mother Church reminds us “Think of the commandments, hate not your neighbor; remember the Most High’s covenant, and overlook faults.” Sir 28:7

People are always changing and going through phases. We are loved. We are called to forgive. We are called to change our hearts with the help of the Lord. Yes, we are called to reconcile and learn to be in relation with others life in the story, *Stone Soup*. Why? Each person is loved by God equally. We are loved. ‘coz we love, we give.

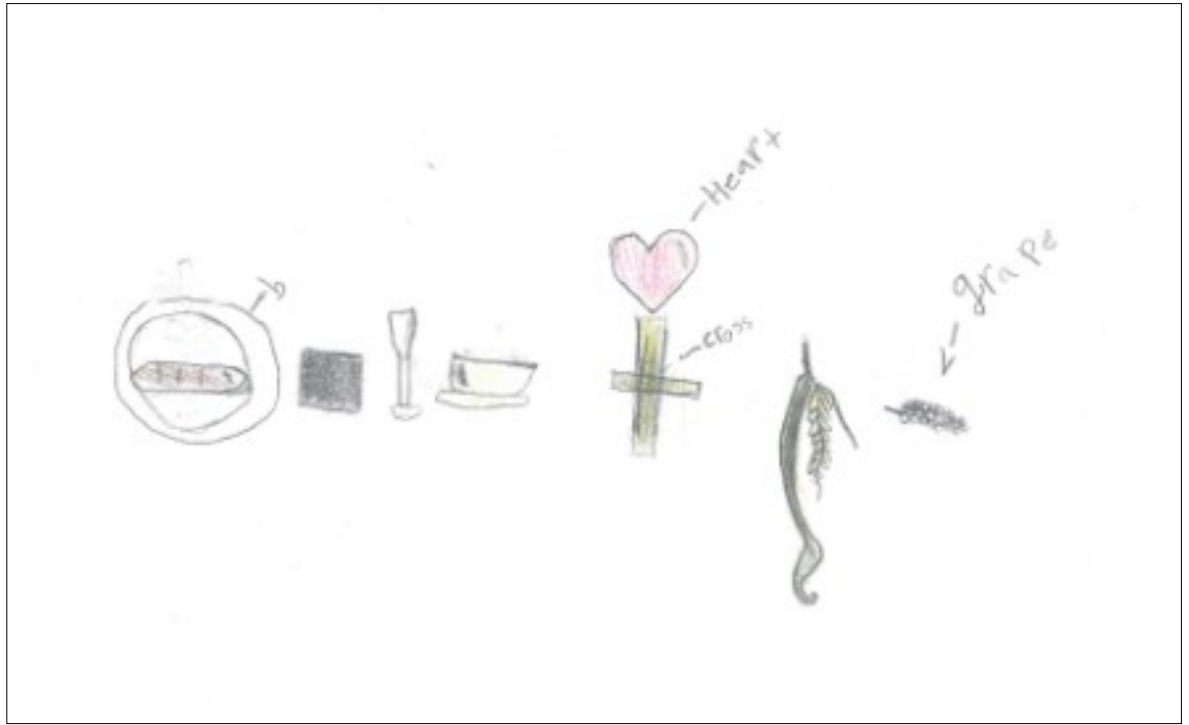

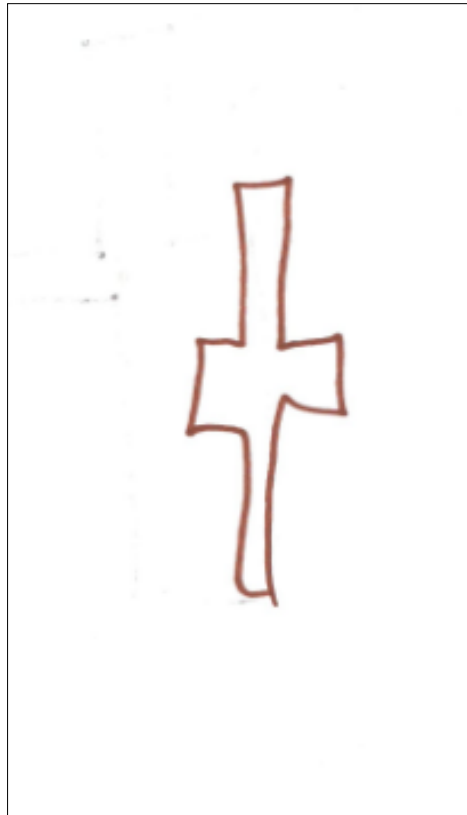

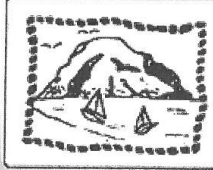
