The 1981 movie, *Chariots of Fire*, is based on the true story of Eric Liddell and Harold Abrahams, 1924 Olympic runners. Liddell, a Christian, made news because he was the top runner in the 100 meter race, but refused to run the heat because it fell on a Sunday, the Lord's Day. He is quoted in *Chariots of Fire* as saying "God made countries; God makes kings, and the rules by which they govern. And those rules say that the Sabbath is His. And I, for one, intend to keep it that way." Liddell was laughed at and ridiculed, and even hated for not representing his country of Great Britain in the race. Instead he held his head high, ignoring all those around him. While at the Olympics on the morning of his 400 meter final, he was slipped a note which said, "In the old book it says: 'He that honours me I will honour.' Wishing you the best of success always." The quote was 1 Sam 2: 30. Someone besides his coach believed in Liddell and supported in his Christian values.

It is so tempting to quit when things in life get difficult and discouraging, let alone persecuted against and exhausted from trying to do the right thing and feeling like the world is against us. The Liddell story reminds us of Jeremiah and the burring in his heart to honor God even to the point of becoming an object of laughter of others. This is an example of faith and the real world meeting. This is not an isolated event. We see countless examples in our everyday life. For some reason, especially in our modern age, this idea of faith and the 'real world' have been given the illusion of being divided with faith not relevant to the world at large.

Nicholas Kristof, journalist for the New York Times in an opinion article (Nicholas Kristof. Aug 23, 2023) writes, "Evidence is growing that Americans are becoming significantly less religious. They are drifting away from churches, they are praying less and they are less likely to say religion is very important in their lives." The article brings in research data collected by Gallop polls and the Pew Research Center and explores the concept of 'dechuraching.' In another place it states, "The loss of religious community has far-reaching implications. Congregations are a crucial part of America's social capital, providing companionship,

food pantries and a pillar of community life." Could you imagine a life without our Holy Mother Church? Without God? Yes, perhaps even without God we could still be generous to others, to think about others and care for our communities; All over the United States there are Atheist organizations that welcome atheists, agnostics and science based skeptics and offer idea sharing, speakers, critical thinking forums, fundraising and community service, among many more things: Perhaps they are following Pascal's wager, though they say that they are not deists?

Unlike these types of groups, Holy Mother Church has something very special. We HAVE God. To acknowledge our Lord God can make us unpopular as Catholic Christians, for example, former U.S. President John F. Kennedy was criticized and suspect in the eyes of some for simply being Catholic. Saint Mother Theresa is another example of loving God so she served her sisters, and especially the poor in India only, to be faced with hateful speech about her forcing people to live in communal houses and hospitals where critics accused her of poor medical treatment for them, among other things while others accused her of evangelizing for such reasons as crosses hung in the hospitals and last rites offered to the dying Faithful.

Holy Mother Church is a living example of Faith meeting the real world. We believe in Christ our Savior and are called as Baptized Catholics to be partakers in his Mission on Earth, to live the Beatitudes: *to know, to love, and to serve him, and so to come to paradise...With beatitude, man enters into the glory of Christ and into the joy of the Trinitarian life.* (CCC 1721) Faith in Christ leads us to good works that glorify God the Father through the Holy Spirit. Saint James in his letter wrote, "...faith of itself, if it does not have works, is dead."

So following our Mother the Church, we support each other and offer hope, the Light of Christ, during difficult moments of despair and despondency. We do this through prayer, through being present, and through service to others. Think of the times you have given, or experienced this at Mass, or through other parishioners, past or present. It's God's love in the world & 'coz we love, we give.

QUEENSHIP OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY



Tues. Aug. 22nd we celebrated the Queenship of the Blessed Virgin Mary. It is a Memorial prescribed in 1954 by Pope Pius XII is celebrated now on the octave day of the Assumption. It was moved from May 31 in 1969 by Pope Paul VI, during a revision of the General Calendar. Actually the feasts of the Immaculate Heart of Mary

and the Queenship of Mary were switched so the Feast of the Sacred Heart of Mary could follow that of the Sacred Heart of Jesus in Mary. The Scriptural basis for Mary being Queen of Heaven and Earth is found in Song of Songs 4:8, Psalm 45: 11-12, and Revelations 12: 1-7. Depictions of Mary as

Queen of Heaven have been around since at least 963 A.D., becoming very popular in the 13th to 15th centuries. The Queenship of the Blessed Virgin Mary is recognized too in the Fifth Glorious Mystery of the Most Holy Rosary of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

Monthly the Faithful at our parish gather to share in the Mass and then

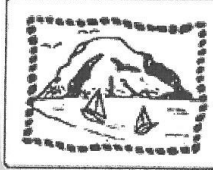
