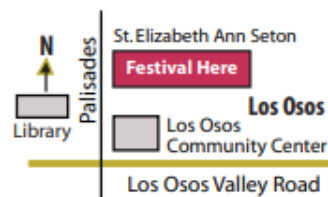

During the 1980s and 1990s in what is now called Silicon Valley, there was still agricultural production, a lingering remnant of the eleven major canneries that had packed and canned the produce farmed in Santa Clara Valley and surrounding areas for decades. It was not uncommon therefore to visit the local hardware store midmorning and see thirty to forty men waiting in the shade of the building to be selected by farmers in need of one or two more persons to help in the field, or even those working in construction who could use a couple more persons. During the day, if more supplies were needed, another trip would be made to the hardware store and more men hired. The numbers of day workers waiting in the shade of the building would dwindle during the day as people took on jobs and left with their 'new' employer. Then at the end of the day, everyone would be dropped back at the hardware store so they could go home after being paid. Observing this for years brings home the message of the parable of the Kingdom of Heaven being like the Master that goes out and hires laborers for his vineyard at different times of the day. (Mt 20:1-6)

There is an understanding of firm results needed in agriculture. There is a need to fill a certain number of bags with cotton, or baskets with cherries and apricots. It is not uncommon to pay a laborer based upon the number of containers filled because at harvest time, the produce left on the plant rots and is wasted if it is left too long. The extra laborers are then understood to be welcome in bringing in the harvest. The same can be said of the Kingdom of God.

In the context of the Kingdom of God, Holy Mother Church offers her children as examples of those laborers in the 'field' as working toward the harvest for the Kingdom of God. If we were to take for example St. Vincent de Paul, a French Catholic priest, born approximately 1576 to 1581, who dedicated his life to serving the poor. Born to peasant farmers, St. Vincent de Paul was the third child in the family and when he was old enough, his parents sent him to the seminary. He became a priest at the age of nineteen. There are narratives of his being enslaved by pirates and in a priestly vocation serving other slaves and convicts aboard ships. Our of slavery he continued to serve the poor

by founding institutions that would help them both materially and spiritually. He with St. Louise de Marillac to organize the Daughters of Charity, the first congregation of women religious whose consecrated life involved serving the poor, the sick, and prisoners. St. Vincent de Paul died in 1660 at the approximate age of 84.

His charity to the poor and rule of life would inspire other saints including St. Elizabeth Ann Seton (néé Bailey), the first native born American (born 1774 in New York City, NY) to be declared a saint. Raised within an Episcopalian family, her father was a doctor for New York Harbor and taught at the nearby college. Elizabeth married a wealthy merchant, William Seton. Part of her role as a woman from a wealthy family was to help with charitable causes and feeding the poor. During the Napoleonic War some of her husband's ships were sunk costing them their fortune. In the course of time, William contracted tuberculosis and so they went with their eldest daughter to Italy to stay with business partners, leaving the rest of their children with family until their return. On the way, William died, leaving Elizabeth alone in a foreign country with a young child. It was then that Elizabeth Ann Seton encountered Christ in the Eucharist and carried him back with her in her heart to the New York and became Catholic. She was shunned by family and friends, but took solace in the Catholic Church and the work in the 'field' that Christ would share with her. She would evangelize or share God's Good News. With others established a religious order using a modified version of the rule of St. Vincent de Paul, served the poor, established Catholic schools, and even some hospitals. Though she started 'later in the day' compared to St. Vincent de Paul, it never diminished what she did for Christ. She served our Master and fulfilled the work he gave her just as the Master set work for St. Vincent de Paul, just as the Master gives to each of us in our everyday lives.

The heavenly harvest is still coming in. In what ways are you being called to serve in your family?, your relationships at work and in the community? How is Christ Jesus calling you to share in his work? How are you being called to share his love? We are loved. 'coz we love, we give.

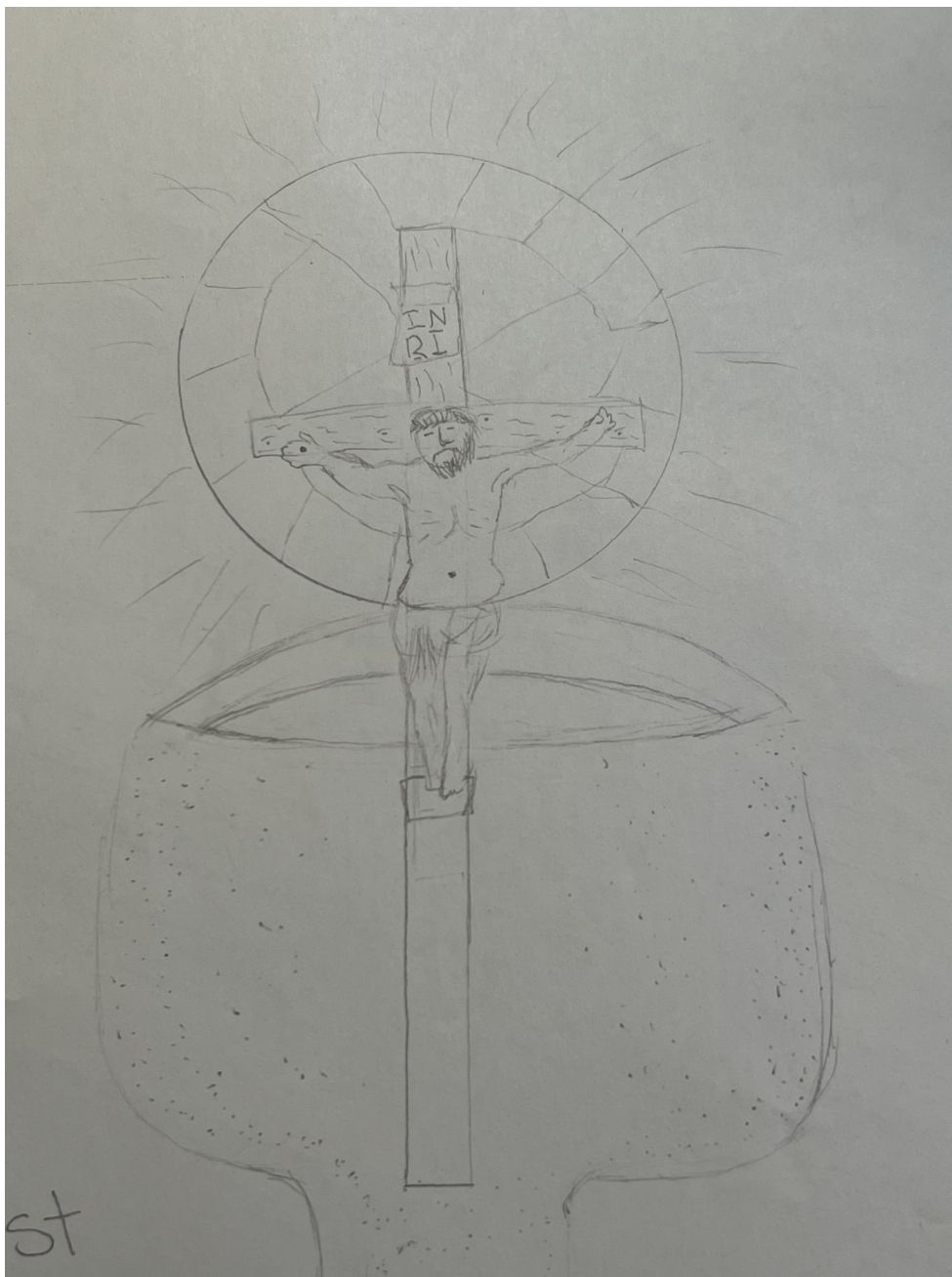

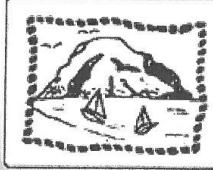
