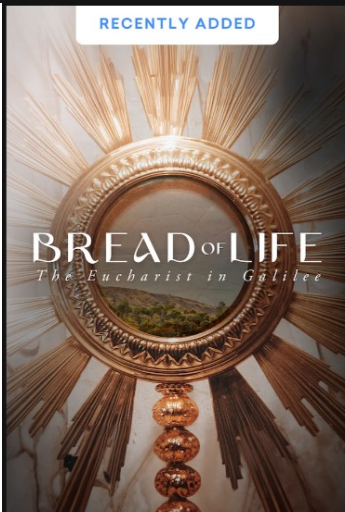

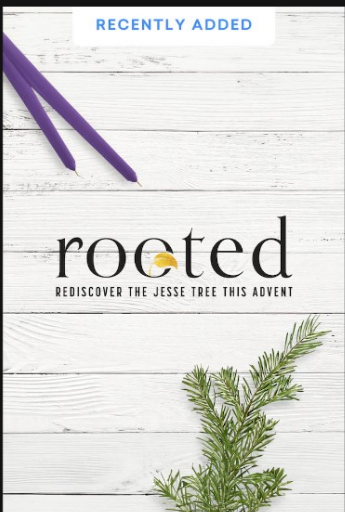

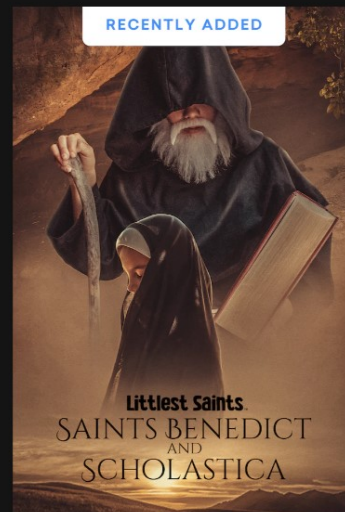

Thank you to everyone who has made a donation or pledge to our TARPS OFF! Capital Campaign to replace our church roof. It is needed! Every time it rains tarps are needed to cover the pews because rain seeps through cracks and rotting wood into the ceiling.

Here is the catch: If you regularly contribute to our weekly donation, we need for you to continue contributing to that. We need to have a continued weekly income from donations for parish operations, utilities, and other expenses of running a parish.

Donations given for the Tarps Off Capital Campaign cannot be shared with other funds at the parish. That is why your continued donation to the weekly collection is so important. Donations to the Tarps Off Capital Campaign must be made in addition to the regular donation you may give our parish.

We humbly ask you to pray about what you and your family may be able to contribute to our Capital Campaign this year when all donations for the roof go directly to the roof replacement and the Diocesan assessment is waived for this fund. One time donations are welcome. Monthly pledges are also available. Please join our "Donor Choir of Angels" today!

### FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

**Q: Is S.E.A.S. a nonprofit?**

**A:** Yes! St. Elizabeth Ann Seton is a church and is a 501 (c)(3). Donations are tax deductible.

**Q: Do you accept stocks?**

**A:** Yes. We can accept stocks and bonds as donation.

**Q: Can I ask my employer to be a matching donor?**

**A:** Yes. Often businesses are willing to match their employee contributions to different causes.

**Q: May I give a small amount now, and more later?**

**A:** Absolutely! Your direct donations are being recorded for tax purposes. Your accrued total donations determine the tier for which you will be recognized.

**Q: What are some of the fundraising events for this coming year to support TARPS OFF!**

**A:** Tentative ideas are Tamale sales, Dinner & Dance, Live Auctions, Ballroom Dance, Kermes, etc. Some are already in the planning stages, some not yet.

**Q: Some funds were collected for the roof in 2023. What happened to that money?**

**A:** That money is still set aside for the roof replacement. The Diocese requires parishes to have half the loan amount needed before giving a parish a loan. This money was what was required to receive the loan for the roof.

**Q: Did the amount needed for the roof change from 2023 to 2024?**

**A:** Yes. With the 2023 rise in costs for building materials the companies who gave bids readjusted their proposals. 'Surprises' due to wood rot were also factored into bids.

**Q: If the parish collects more than is needed to repay the loan, where will that money go?**

**A:** Any money collected beyond the \$200,000 to repay the loan will be placed into our parish savings account for the months when annually Sunday collections, especially the summer months and holiday breaks when parishioners travel, are lean and we barely receive enough funding, and sometimes don't, for parish operations.

**Q: How much does the parish hope to keep in savings?**

**A:** It is recommended that the parish keep at least \$50,000 in savings for lean months and unexpected expenses. The more of course is better.

Ordinary Time is our opportunity to hear through Sacred Scripture about the works of Jesus. Throughout the Sundays of Ordinary Time, we are invited to participate in the life and ministry of Jesus and contemplate him. Ordinary Time calls us to ponder on the Paschal Mystery and our call to discipleship and sharing in Christ’s ministry throughout the year. It is also a time of growing and maturing in our faith life.

Since the launch of the James Webb Space Telescope the world has been shown images of space: stars, nebulae, and planets with better focus and refinement than in the past. Similarly, we are called to refocus and refine and grow our faith lives. How do we do this? We can live the seasons of the Church, hear the Scripture, and follow Jesus’ life during the ordinary times and how he lived during Easter, the Nativity. We can also learn more about the Saints and how they matured in their faith to be inspired and given an example. We can do this by reading about them, through audio recordings, movies, books and even their own words. Being part of a Scripture study group or faith sharing group can be helpful. Perhaps we can take classes from universities to ‘go deep.’ Some folks receive Catholic magazine subscriptions while others receive daily text messages with Scripture readings. Maybe we can attend Mass to be nourish by Christ and hear the Holy Scriptures broken open and related to our own lives. These are ways we can mature in our faith. Reflecting upon Church teaching and Scripture and being challenged can makes us stronger in faith and can solidify what we believe as Catholics. As Christians our lives and the way we live them should point to Jesus Christ Our Lord and Savior.

Can we live a Christ-centric life today? That is a question that many struggle with. With the potential for war, disease, famine, and wildfires, our thoughts may be on the challenges the world around us bring into our lives. Holy

Mother Church asks us to take a step back and into ourselves, into that place within us where God dwells. The Church through Sacred Scripture and Tradition reminds us that the temple of the Holy Spirit is within us. (1 Cor 6: 19) That is our Sacred Space away from the world.

There was at St. Andrew’s Abbey in Valyermo, CA, at the Benedictine Monastery, a Brother Peter Zhou Bangjiu, O.S.B. Brother Peter suffered under the horrors of communist China for many years. He wrote a book, *Dawn Breaks in the East: One Spiritual Warrior’s Thirty-three Year Struggle in Defense of the Church*, that he composed while he lived in prison often in solitary confinement with only memorized Scripture passages to help him through the difficulties of his torture. Decades of meditation upon Scripture allowed Brother Peter’s faith to mature and develop. When he was freed and able to come to the United States this quiet man was encouraged to share his story and his love for God through his beautiful poetry composed in his mind while in the darkness of his prison cell. In his later years at the monastery Brother Peter was considered a quiet prayerful humble man who was conscientiously mindful of serving others. Many today consider his maturity of faith and outpouring of love through his life the reason he was considered a living Saint. Brother Peter died in May of 2022 at the age of ninety-five.

We do not need to live what Brother Peter lived, but to take his lessons of praying daily, of learning Holy Scripture and meditating on them, and living the faith by sharing God’s love with others. Like Brother Peter who retained that temple of the Holy Spirit alive within him during his difficulties, let us visit God interiorly as well on a regular basis. We are called to be Saints. Let us ask the Holy Spirit to guide us in our daily lives to bring about that joy and love that God sets in our hearts. Let us refocus our hearts and lives back on Christ. ‘cuz we love, we give!



## SACRIS SOLEMNIIS

At this our solemn feast  
let holy joys abound,  
and from the inmost breast  
let songs of praise resound;  
let ancient rites depart,  
and all be new around,  
in every act, and voice, and heart.

Remember we that eve,  
when, the Last Supper spread,  
Christ, as we all believe,  
the Lamb, with leavenless bread,  
among His brethren shared,  
and thus the Law obeyed,  
of all unto their sire declared.

The typic Lamb consumed,  
the legal Feast complete,  
the Lord unto the Twelve  
His Body gave to eat;  
the whole to all, no less  
the whole to each did mete  
with His own hands, as we confess.

He gave them, weak and frail,  
His Flesh, their Food to be;  
on them, downcast and sad,  
His Blood bestowed He:  
and thus to them He spake,  
"Receive this Cup from Me,

and all of you of this partake."

So He this Sacrifice  
to institute did will,  
and charged His priests alone  
that office to fulfill:  
to them He did confide:  
to whom it pertains still  
to take, and the rest divide.

Thus Angels' Bread is made  
the Bread of man today:  
the Living Bread from heaven  
with figures dost away:  
O miraculous gift indeed!  
the poor and lowly may  
upon their Lord and Master feed.

Thee, therefore, we implore,  
O Godhead, One in Three,  
so may Thou visit us  
as we now worship Thee;  
and lead us on Thy way,  
That we at last may see  
the light wherein Thou dwellest aye.

### St. Thomas Aquinas (1225-1274)

*Sacris Solemniis* is a hymn written by St. Thomas Aquinas for the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, also known as the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. Other popular songs frequently used at Adoration were also written by St. Thomas Aquinas and are part of longer hymns also written for the Solemnity of Corpus Christi.

The second to last or penultimate stanza of *Sacris Solemniis* in Latin is famously known as the hymn *Panis Angelicus* (*Bread of Angels*), which has been frequently been set to music and sung as its own hymn by musicians starting in the 1800s to our current era.

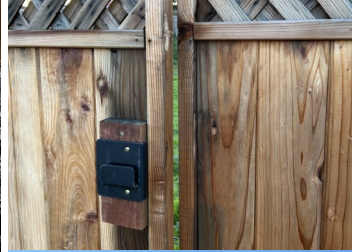
## TARPS ON... AGAIN

## ELECTION POLL INSPECTION

For years our parish has been an election poll site. It is a source of funding for our parish. Only the community room is used and the sacred space in the church is cordoned off by stanchions to prohibit entry into the sanctuary by poll volunteers.

This last Friday county officials came to inspect our church property to ensure it remains compliant to the needed standards for voter poll integrity and ADA compliance. They measured a great deal including distance between the community room side door to the ramp run in the large parking lot as well as the height of the curbs, doorways, and more. If you drove through the parking lot and saw the county vehicle, this is what they were doing.

## SORTING RECYCLING/GARBAGE

This last week we had representatives from the County's waste management authority come to speak to us about the new state laws that have come into effect as of January 1st, 2024.

There are new rules and things to remember for all of use to follow at the church for those helping clean after Hospitality, People's Kitchen, food sales, the parish festival, parish social gatherings, those involved with general cleaning, and other gatherings.

Greetings Residents,

The new California state mandate SB 1383 applies to all persons and entities that generate organic material such as food scraps and plant trimmings. *Everyone* is required to divert their organic material from the garbage into a green/organics cart, which is now on site as part of your garbage service. Please look over the provided informational flyers explaining the state mandate and how to sort and dispose of different types of waste.

The Integrated Waste Management Authority (IWMA) provides free kitchen food waste containers for residents, available either at your Management Office on site or at our SLO office at 870 Osos Street.

The following organic materials are to be placed in the green cart:

- All food waste, including bones and shells
- Food soiled paper towels and napkins
- Yard/plant waste
- Craft brown paper bags, newspaper or other plain uncoated paper used to line green waste containers or carts

Items **NOT** allowed in the green cart:

- **NO** plastic liners/bags or packaging, including compostable bags
- **NO** paper, bamboo or other commercially compostable food containers, tableware or flatware with plastic, waxy or shiny coating of any kind (including paper coffee cups)
- **NO** liquids
- **NO** plastic, Styrofoam, glass, or metal items

As a reminder, a blue recycle receptacle can be found on site. Our local recycling facility has requested that **NO PLASTIC BAGS or FILM** of any kind go into the recycling. Please dispose of your recyclable items (all rigid plastic, glass, cans, paper and flattened cardboard) directly into the blue bin **with NO bags**.

Integrated Waste Management Authority (IWMA) proporciona contenedores para los restos de comida para los residentes interesados sin consto alguno. Están disponibles en la oficina de su apartamento o en nuestra oficina, 870 Osos Street en San Luis Obispo.

Los desechos orgánicos que pertenecen en el contenedor verde son los siguientes:

- Desperdicios de comida, incluyendo huesos y conchas
- Servilletas de papel usadas con comida
- Restos de poda
- Bolsas de papel usadas con restos de comida

Artículos que **NO** son permitidos en el contenedor verde:

- **NO** bolsas de plástico o plástico de empacar, incluyendo plástico compostable
- **NO** contenedores de papel para comida que contenga plástico, cera o capa brillante (incluyendo vasos de papel para café)
- **NO** líquidos
- **NO** plásticos, poliestireno, vidrio, o metales

Recuerde, hay reciclaje en este sitio. Nuestro centro de reciclaje **NO permite BOLSAS de PLASTICO O PLASTICO DE EMPACAR**. Favor de tirar su reciclaje como, todo plástico rígido, vidrio, latas, papel limpio, y cartón aplanado, directamente en el contenedor azul **sin bolsa**.

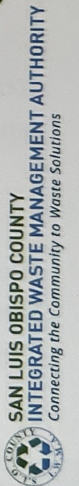

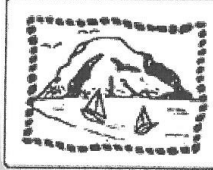
