## GOSPEL MK 7:1-8, 14-15, 21-23

And on coming from the marketplace they do not eat without purifying themselves. ## EVANGELIO MC 7, 1-8. 14-15. 21-23

Nada que entre de fuera puede manchar al hombre; lo que sí lo mancha es lo que sale de dentro; porque del corazón del hombre salen las intenciones malas, las fornicaciones, los robos, los homicidios, los adulterios, las codicias, las injusticias, los fraudes, el desenfreno, las envidias, la difamación, el orgullo y la frivolidad. Todas estas maldades salen de dentro y manchan al hombre".




